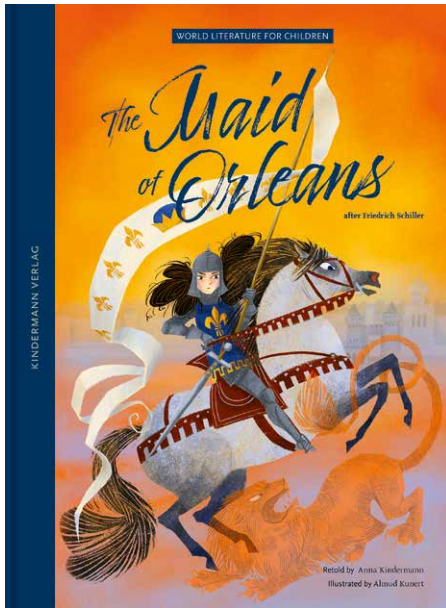
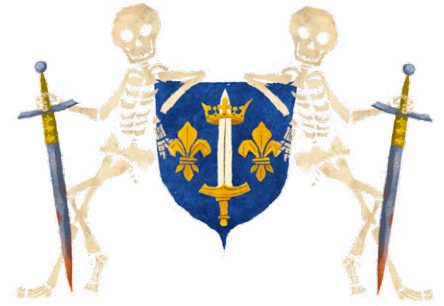

On the battlefield, she must then face two conflicts: on the one hand, that of her country against England and, on the other, a greater conflict between love and duty.

Anna Kindermann retells the famous legend in a child-friendly way. Almud Kunert's colourful illustrations depict the eventful story of the young woman who became a national symbol of France.
